## ☐ Confirm you are fully enrolled in SCIP, SCIP+, or eSCIP and an approved course(s) • Confirm your enrollment by accessing your Registration Portal using your 5-digit registration number • Confirm course(s) enrollment by logging into your MyUCLA account; the default page after you login will be your Study List and will show all active course enrollments ☐ Confirm your BruinBill is fully paid and the balance due is zero • Check your BruinBill on your MyUCLA account under the "Finances and Jobs" tab; if there is any outstanding balance, you are at risk of being dropped from the program and/or courses ☐ Confirm your email address in MyUCLA "Settings" • Find the "Settings" tab in the upper right corner and select "Official Email/Phone/Address" • If the official email is set to your UCLA email and you are okay with receiving your main communication here, you can access your UCLA email at g.ucla.edu. Please note you will lose access to your UCLA email after the summer term ends ☐ Familiarize yourself with BruinLearn class websites and watch the BruinLearn tutorial • If you do not see your classes on BruinLearn, your instructor may not have activated the class website; most instructors will not activate their class website until the week before classes begin • Read through the syllabus and check for textbooks and any other required materials needed ☐ Check your email for communications from your program coordinator and instructor(s) • Most instructors will send an introductory email within 1-3 days before your course begins; if you need to contact your instructor, you can check the UCLA Directory or BruinLearn to find their email • A SCIP specific introductory email with housing check-in instructions will be sent 1-2 weeks before the start of the program; for more housing info, please review our Housing for Minors page
