Eligibility Requirements:

To apply for BASE, you must meet ALL of the following minimum eligibility criteria:

- ✓ You are a California high school student currently in Grades 10 or 11 for Spring 2025;
- ✓ You have a minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA (unweighted);
- ✓ You have not applied to UCLA Summer Sessions' Summer Scholars Support for 2025 or been a recipient of Summer Scholars Support in the past; and
- ✓ You meet our family income eligibility, which takes into account the California county you live in and the number of members in your household (Click here for more details).
