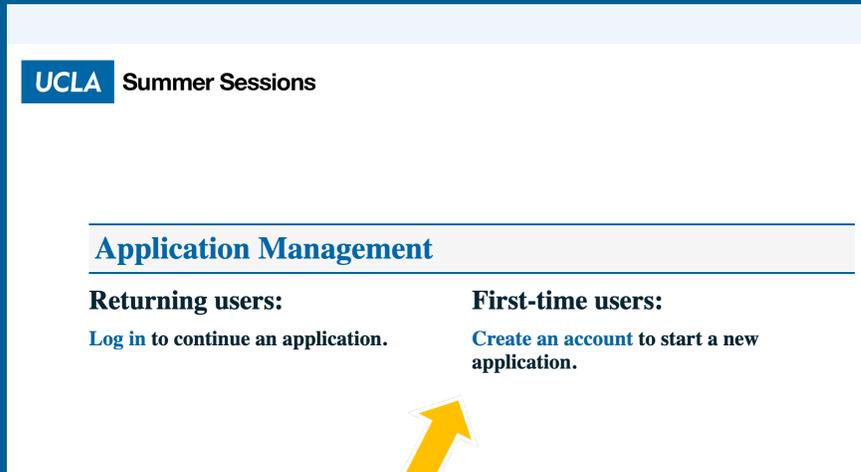

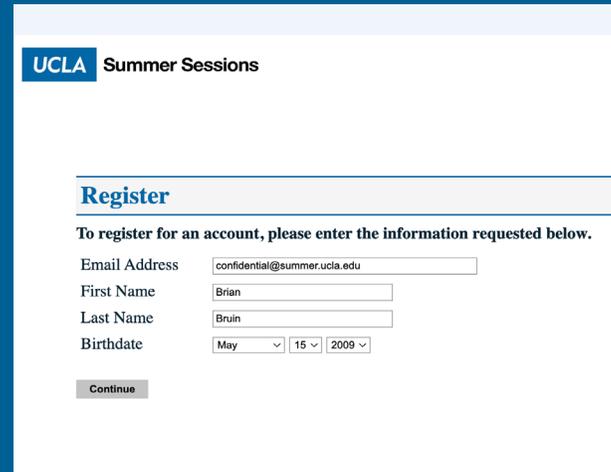

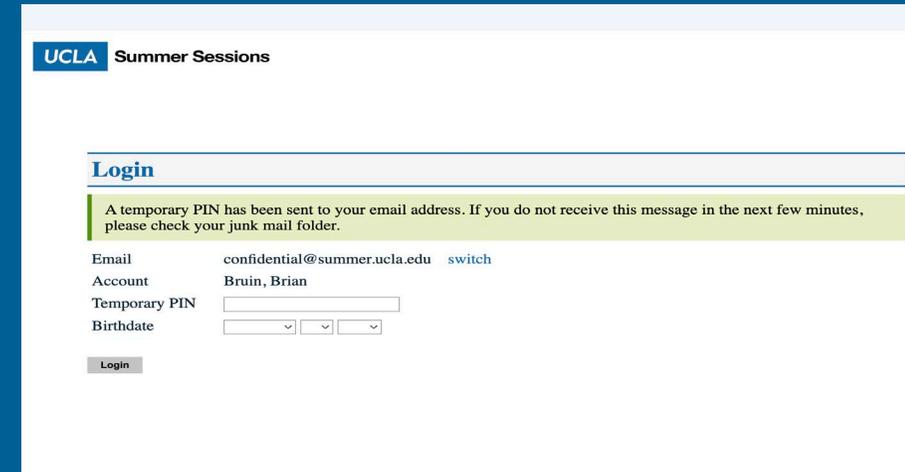

**Eligibility**  
Students must be 15 years of age or older by the first day of Summer Sessions (June 22, 2026). Some programs may have additional eligibility or admission requirements. We recommend verifying the specific eligibility requirements and any required application materials on the appropriate program page of the [Summer Sessions website](#).

**Application Management**  
All students will be required to provide personal and academic background information on the following pages. You will then select your program of interest on the **Program Selection** page. Additional application pages will be added based on the program you choose and must be completed in order to submit your application.

The application automatically saves your responses, and you may return to your Student Portal at any time to continue your application. If your selected program requires materials to

**NOTE:** Summer Scholars will only cover SCIP (SCIP, SCIP+, or eSCIP), a Summer Precollege Focus Series, or a HS Approved Course.

- If selecting **Summer Precollege Focus Series**, students will be prompted to choose their specific program (e.g., Engineering Design, Economics, TeenArch Studio, etc.) and upload their application materials on the next page. - If selecting **Summer Courses**, these offerings refer to UCLA academic courses and do not include Summer Precollege Focus Series programs. High school students must enroll in courses from the [Pre-Approved Course List](#). Students will select their courses after they submit this application.
- If selecting **College/Professional Summer Institutes**, high school students may only apply to the Traditional Animation or Voiceover Camera Acting programs under this category.

**\*NOTE:** If you are seeking to apply to the Summer College Immersion Program or a Summer Precollege Focus Series, the Summer Scholars Support Application will **NOT** appear on the Status Portal **until** you have gained admission into the program.

- Most programs will take **2-3 weeks** to provide you with an acceptance decision. Be sure to leave enough time to apply to your program and learn of your admission **BY APRIL 1** to ensure you will have an admission decision. Students still waiting for admission decisions for programs on/after April 1 are ineligible to receive a scholarship.

Students seeking to register in a Summer Course(s) **do not** require an admission decision and may view the Summer Scholars Support Application on the Status Portal once they have submitted their application.

# STEP 5: Supplemental Page

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## Supplement: Summer Precollege Focus Series

The UCLA Summer Precollege Focus Series gives students hands-on experience with real world skills that go beyond the traditional classroom.

**Eligibility**  
Students must be 15 years of age or older by June 22, 2026. Additional eligibility requirements vary by program; please visit the [program page](#) on the Summer Sessions website for more information. All Summer Precollege Focus Series students must upload an unofficial academic transcript. Please be sure to have one on hand prior to attempting registration.

**UCLA Summer Sessions does not manage or arrange housing.** If you are 17+ and enrolled in a Summer Precollege Focus Series program, you may apply for housing through the [UCLA Housing](#) application which opens in mid-May.

**Participant Agreement**  
Applicants and their parent/legal guardians are required to complete the Participant Agreement. You will have access to the Participant Agreement in your Student Portal after you submit your application. You will be asked to complete all required documents again if adding a new program, switching to a different program, or re-enrolling in the same program after cancellation.

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## Supplement: SCIP

Thank you for your interest in the **Summer College Immersion Program**. To review the eligibility and application requirements, please visit the [SCIP program page](#). This is a six-week program for high achieving students (3.8 minimum GPA) with college-level courses and mandatory co-curricular workshops (M, W, F 3:30-4:30pm PT). Once all application components are successfully submitted, you will receive a confirmation email.

Applicants should **allow up to 3 weeks to receive an admission decision** from [scip@summer.ucla.edu](mailto:scip@summer.ucla.edu) (check your spam/junk email folder). Payment is not required unless you are accepted into the program. If accepted, you will receive an email with instructions to pay the \$350 registration fee. This does NOT cover the full cost of the program. For more information, use the [Fee Calculator](#).

**NOTE:** *Students who prefer to live on campus must be 17 years of age or older by June 22, 2026 to apply for [housing](#) (no exceptions). For questions, contact [UCLA Housing](#); UCLA Summer Sessions does not manage housing.*

**NOTE:** Your application for the Summer Scholars Support is **NOT** complete until you pay the \$350 non-refundable registration fee for your program/course OR request Deferred Deposit. Payment for your program (Summer Precollege Focus Series or SCIP) will become available once you have been accepted and gained a seat within your program. Most programs will take 2-3 weeks to provide you with an acceptance decision. Please be sure to leave enough time to apply to your program and learn of your admission **BY APRIL 1** to ensure you will have an admission decision. Students still waiting for admission decisions for programs on/after April 1 are ineligible to receive a scholarship. Students seeking to register in a Summer Course(s) do not require an admission decision and payment for Summer Courses will be readily available once you submit your application.

### DEFERRED DEPOSIT INSTRUCTIONS

To submit a Deferred Deposit Request, email (confidential@summer.ucla.edu) with the example below alongside your documentation.

1. "Hello, My name is [insert name]. I have [applied or registered] for [Summer Courses, SCIP, or a Summer Precollege Focus Series] and I would like to request Deferred Deposit to be applied on my account. I understand that Deferred Deposit does NOT waive the registration fee and I will be responsible to pay the registration fee, in addition to the other program/tuition fees, if I wish to remain enrolled once scholarship decisions have been made on April 20th. I have attached a copy of [1040 Tax Form, EBT card and ID, Lunch letter] as required documentation for Deferred Deposit. Thank you!"

If your request is approved, we will provide confirmation via email and enroll you in your respective summer offering (Summer Courses, Summer College Immersion Program, or a Summer Precollege Focus Series). If your request is denied or additional documentation is needed, our office will also email you within one week.

- If you applied for a Summer Precollege Focus Series or SCIP, please **do not** submit a Deferred Deposit Request until you have gained acceptance into the program. Once you have been admitted, please email your Deferred Deposit request as our office cannot place Deferred Deposit if your admission is denied or pending.
- If you have registered for a Summer Course, please submit your Deferred Deposit Request **once** you have submitted your registration. Registering for Summer Courses does not require admission.

### PROGRAM & APPLICATION CHANGES

Students seeking to apply to more than one program must list their preferred program/course they are seeking to receive a scholarship for. If awarded, the scholarship will cover the preferred program/course as listed in the application. Applicants **must notify our office by 5pm PDT on March 15** if their preferred program/course has changed and/or if their program/course is full or waitlisted. Failure to notify of such changes may result in delays in processing your application or may result in a denial.

We appreciate your commitment to the application process. It is important to note that we cannot make any edits once the application deadline has passed. Our deadline is carefully set to ensure a fair and organized review process for all applicants. We highly recommend thoroughly reviewing your information before hitting the "Submit Application" button to avoid errors or inaccuracies.

Please attach a copy of your student resume. Be sure that your resume isn't simply a block of text across the page, rather formatted and detailed enough where we can gain an understanding of who you are. Accepted file types are Word (.docx) or PDF (.pdf) document.

Applicants will select 3 out of the 6 questions below and answer each question in 250 – 300 words. Personal statements should be saved in one single Word (.docx) or PDF (.pdf) document. Please include the question you have selected above each answer.

1. Describe a pivotal experience in your education and how it has shaped the person you are today and/or your goals for the future.
2. Describe a significant challenge you have faced. How has it affected you and what steps have you taken to overcome it?
3. What class or extracurricular activity has had the biggest impact on you, and why?
4. Why are you interested in the program and/or course you have registered for, and what do you hope to get out of it?
5. Describe a community you are a part of. Why is it important to you, and what role have you had in that community?
6. What issue are you passionate about, and why? How have you acted on that passion?

Applicants will be notified of award announcements by **5pm PDT on Monday, April 20, via email**. Applicants may be awarded, waitlisted, or **\*\*denied**; please refer to our email for more information when released.

**\*\*In the event you apply for a scholarship and are **NOT** granted one, you will still be responsible to pay the registration fee, in addition to the other program/tuition fees, *if you wish to remain enrolled*. If you decide **NOT** to continue with your program/course enrollment after **NOT** being selected for a scholarship and **paid** the registration fee, please follow the instructions via email on April 20th on how to request your refund for the registration fee.**
